Hindi Poem Writing Competition:

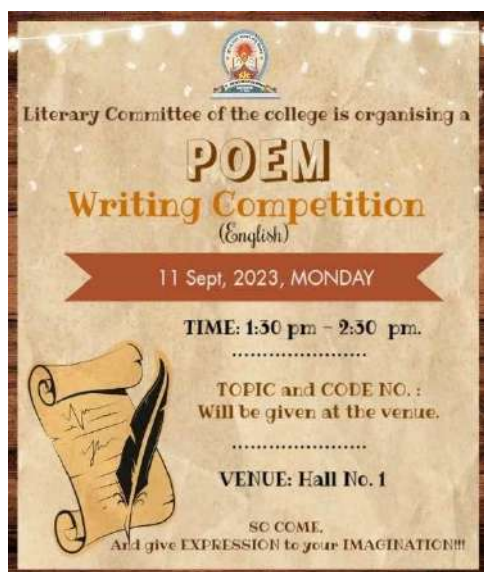

Hindi Essay Writing Competition:

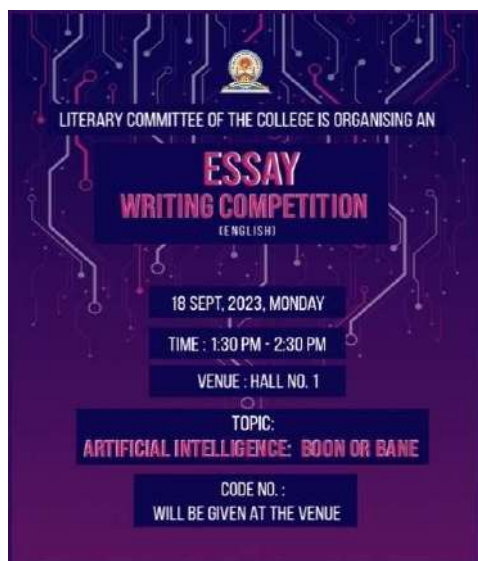

Hindi Short Story Writing Competition:

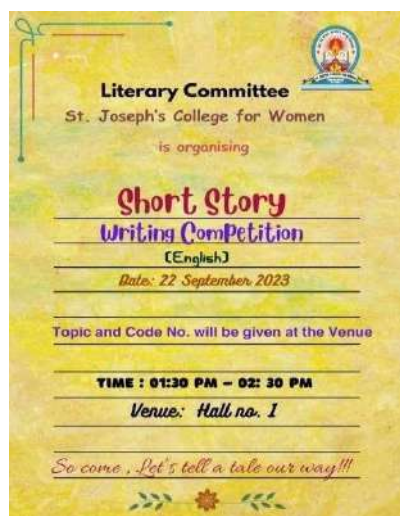

Hindi Speech Competition:

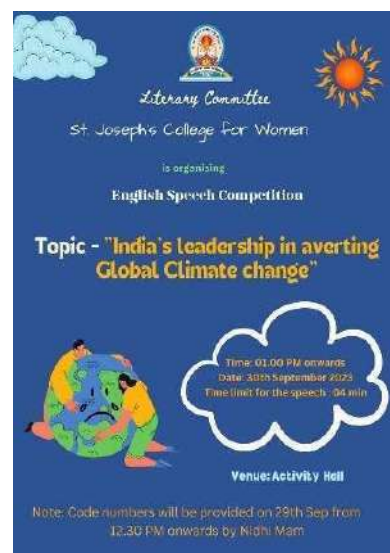

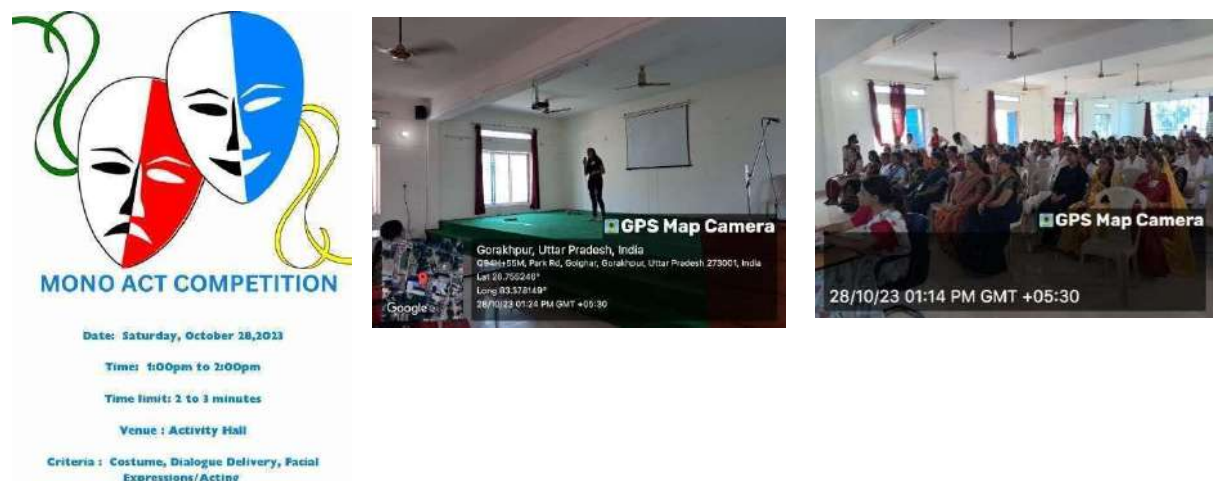
Rangoli Competition

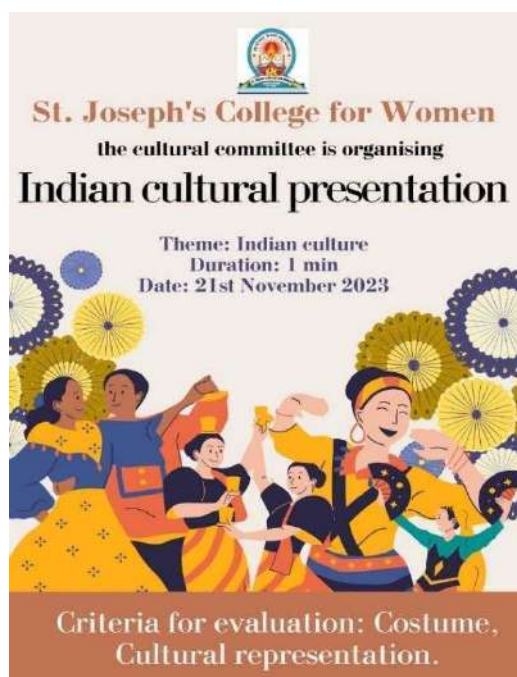


Josphiesta

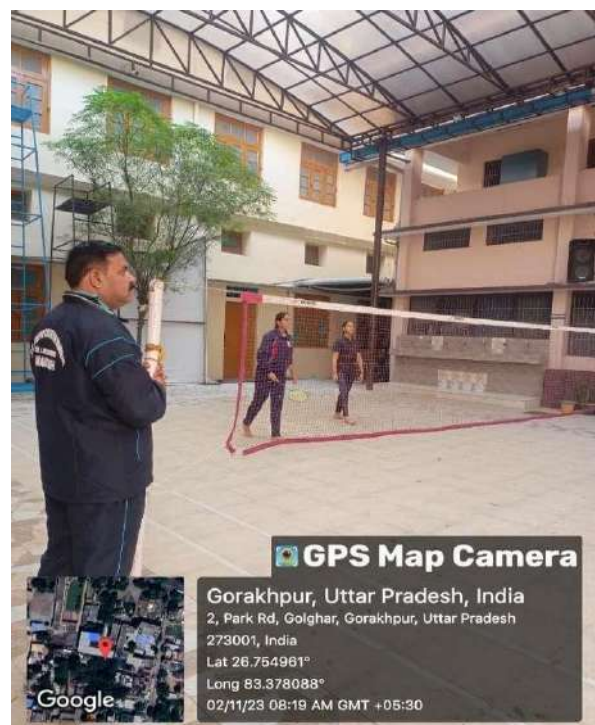

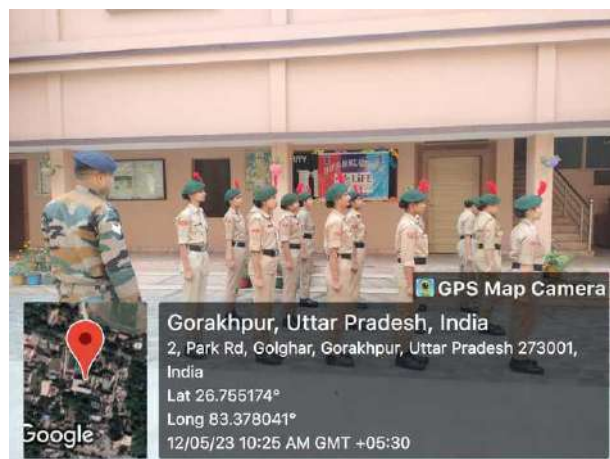
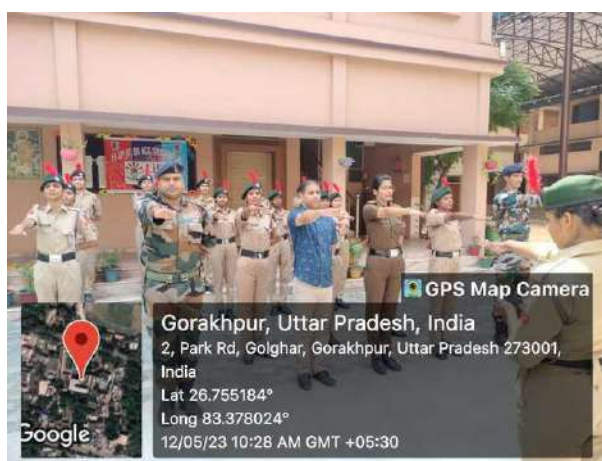
Social Service

Cadet selection for the new academic year

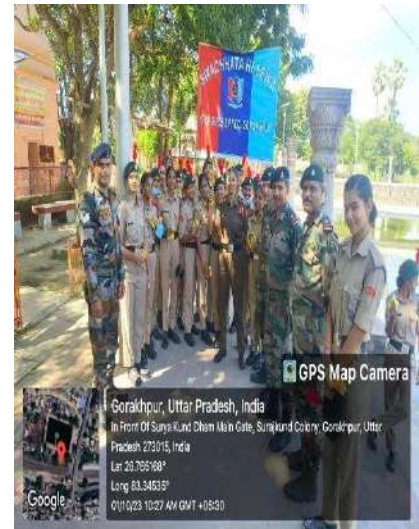
