

Make everyone a fully mature person capable of understanding things properly, speak intelligibly and behave politely.


Inculcate in everyone eternal values that are essential to life and cultivate good habits to form a refined character.



COLLEGE UNIFORM

All students of B.A., B.Sc., B.Ed. and B.T.C. have to wear the uniform prescribed by the college. B.A. and B.Sc. will have the Salwar suit while B.Ed. and B.T.C. students have the prescribed colour for the saree and blouse.

SEMESTER AND PRE UNIVERSITY EXAMS

Conducting regularly semester and pre-university exams as immediate preparation for the final exams help the students to fare well. The promotion of the students depend on these exams.

SEMINARS AND CONFERENCES

TUTORIAL SYSTEM

The teachers handle the tutorial Sessions. The students are helped to grow integral. There are common and individual sessions arranged and programmes conducted for the cultural, social, emotional, psychological and intellectual growth of the students.

STUDENTS COUNCIL

The students participate in the governance of the college through students council. It is constituted by the President, Vice President, Secretaries and Class Representatives through College election.

REMEDIAL CLASSES

The students who do not perform well in the home exams are given the special care and closely monitored. The under performers along with their parents are called to the Centre for a meaningful discussion to sort out problems and find remedies. The remedial classes are regularly conducted.

STUDENTS AID FUND

We encourage our students to feel with the marginalized and the poor people in our society. The financial assistance and concessions are given to the students of financially backward classes.

PTWA AND ALUMNAE

The College has an Alumnae Association. The Association is founded with a view to establish contact with the passed out students of the college and to build up in them a sense of belonging to the Alma Mater.





APPLYING FOR ADMISSION

Admission to SJCW is competitive. We encourage applicants from diverse social, cultural, economic, ethnic and geographical backgrounds.

ELIGIBILITY FACTORS

SJCW gives preference to the students coming from the neighbouring districts. The inclusive tradition of the college welcomes students from other states and countries.

Students who have completed the Higher Secondary Course or equivalent examination conducted by any state board recognized by the University of Gorakhpur, are eligible for admission to the Bachelor's degree course of B.A and B.Sc.

The students who have successfully completed the under graduation with English literature as one of the subjects in the final year, recognized by the University of Gorakhpur, are eligible for admission.

If the results are not published by any board before the last date of submission of application, the students are asked to meet the Principal.

The students for B.Ed and B.T.C will have to fulfill all the criteria demanded by the DDU Gorakhpur University and State of Uttar Pradesh respectively. (regarding age, percentage of marks, years of gap etc.)

Xerox copy of the JEE Merit statement and the Admit card for B.Ed.

Incomplete application forms and applications received after the last date will be rejected.

Any incorrect, false or misleading information in the application form will disqualify the applicant and if already admitted, will lead to the cancellation of her admission.

SELECTION PROCESS

ENTRANCE TEST

An Entrance test B.Sc. (Maths and Bio) & M.A. English will be conducted on the prescribed date by the college. The students seeking admission for B.Ed and B.T.C. will have to appear for JEE, by UP State, and entrance test by the college respectively.

INTERVIEW

The students whose names are in the Merit List should face an interview with the principal. All the original documents of all certificates enclosed with admission application should be produced for verification.

They have to present themselves/along with parents for interview with the Principal on the date mentioned.

Their absence till the scheduled date will only lead to cancellation of Admission.

FEES PAYMENT

The provisionally selected candidate can pay the prescribed fees at the College fee counter, in cheque or DD drawn in favour of St. Joseph's College for Women, payable at Gorakhpur, or through digital mode/payment gateway mode.

SPECIAL NOTE

The Principal may refuse or cancel admission granted provisionally or otherwise to any individual on valid reasons. No candidate shall be entitled to claim admission as a matter of right.

WITHDRAWAL

The enrolled students are expected to complete their course of study. She may not withdraw from the college without informing the Principal in writing. Otherwise she will be liable to pay fees for the period her name remains in the rolls.

Course fee once submitted will not be refunded even if the admission is withdrawn.



NOTE TO STUDENTS

The college expects the students to be highly focused in academics and make maximum use of the facilities available for holistic development. No student is allowed to take tuition privately from the teachers of this college. Exams will be conducted periodically. Attendance is compulsory and promotion will depend on their regularity.

DISCIPLINARY NORMS

SICW is dedicated not only to learning and advancement of knowledge but also to developing ethical and responsible human beings. The disciplinary policies are made with this uncompromising perspective.
